

Explore the countryside and heritage of Salford with this series of walks around our surprisingly rural city.



A 50 mile trail entirely within the city boundaries.

Split into ten walks each between 4 and 7 miles long.


Designed to connect with public transport at the end of each walk.



The Salford Trail was created by Manchester and Salford Ramblers Leaflets were designed with the support of Salford City Council.

The [Salford Trail](#) goes through rural areas and green spaces, with a little road walking in between. Starting from the cityscape of Salford Quays, it passes beside rivers and canals, through country parks, fields, woods and moss lands, using footpaths, tracks, tow paths and disused railway lines ('loop lines'). It circles around to pass through Kersal, Agecroft, Walkden, Boothstown and Worsley before heading off to Irlam and Chat Moss. The Trail returns to Salford Quays from Barton swing aqueduct (the only one in the world!) via Eccles.

It's easy walking but not designed for cycling. Some sections are suitable for wheelchair users.



The best place to join The Salford Trail from Ellesmere Park is at Dukes Drive in Monton. This is [Walk 7](#) which goes along the Bridgewater Canal to Barton with an option to turn right to join Port Salford Greenway. The Greenway leads to Brookhouse and the start of [Walk 9](#) out across the mosslands towards Irlam.
